Salmon Tours – Saturday, November 10, 2012

Celebrate the return of the salmon to Kitsap County on Saturday, November 10, 2012. Watch migrating salmon and learn from fish biologists at two locations on Chico Creek in Bremerton: The Mountaineers Kitsap Cabin Forest Theater Property and adjoining Mountaineers Foundation Rhododendron Preserve and at Golf Club Hill Road. This free events run from 10 AM to 2 PM at both locations. Activities are for all ages and include a tour of a restoration site, informational booths, refreshments, and viewing salmon in the stream. Biologists will talk about the various types of salmon in Kitsap, the salmon life cycle and healthy fish habitat.

Dress for the weather and wear comfortable shoes. A visit to Mountaineers Foundation Rhododendron Preserve involves a hike down to the stream through old growth forest. Stop anytime during 10 AM – 2 PM at either site. Salmon talks will be repeated on the hour.
